RULES AND REGULATIONS

Consequence will be given by Law Enforcement immediately for: Hitting, spitting, pushing, and kicking a referee.

1. No one is allowed to play on more than one team of the same sport. If a team allows a player who already played for another team to play with its team, that team will be disqualified and removed from participating in the tournament.
2. A team must have at least seven players to start the game.
3. A team must wear uniforms or same colored shirts to play during the game, all shin guards and shoes are required.
4. A team that does not show up on the field after 10 minutes of calling will forfeit the game and the other team will automatically win.
5. We will follow FIFA rules and regulations.
6. We will have a shootout or penalty kick to break up a tie. Each team will have 5 players to take the kick. Anyone on the team can take the penalty kick. It does not matter if he/her is playing or not playing during regulation game time.
7. Goalie substitution must be made during regulation time to be qualified for shoot out in case of a tied game.
8. Winning teams will be asked to help out as referees and linemen.
9. The referee has total and absolute discretion to judge any violation and penalize violators for any misconduct. No player is allowed to argue with the referee. Coach or captain may ask some questions pertaining to the decision.
10. No conduct such as swearing, name calling, shouting, taunting or pointing fingers directly at referees, linemen, opponents or spectators. A yellow card or red card will be issued. If a player receives two yellow cards, it becomes a red card and that player cannot play anymore game. If that team let that player play the next game, that team will forfeit the game. The other team will automatically win.
11. If a player or a team (two or more players) physically attacks another team such as strikes, kick, spit for any other violent manners, the team will be automatically disqualified from the tournament.
12. A Player or team that has been ejected or disqualified and refuses to leave the field will be handle by Law Enforcement immediately.
13. The New Year Festival and Hmoob Cultural and Community Agency will not responsible for your loss/injury due to personal properties and personal injuries.

VOLLEYBALL

RULES AND REGULATIONS

Consequence will be given by Law Enforcement immediately for: Hitting, spitting, pushing, and kicking a referee.

1. No one is allowed to play on more than one team of the same sport. If a team allows a player who already played for another team to play with its team, that team will be disqualified and removed from participating in the tournament.
2. All players must have their names on the roster or sign-up sheet. No additional names of players will be allowed after the registration is turned in.
3. A team must have at least 5 players to start and finish. The players must wear uniforms or same colored shirts to play during the game.
4. A team that does not show up on the court after 10 minutes of calling will be forfeiture from the game and the other team will automatically win.
5. Winning teams will be asked to help out as referees.
6. The referee has total and absolute discretion to judge any violation and penalize violators for any misconduct. No player is allowed to argue with the referee. Coach or captain may ask some questions pertaining to the decision.
7. Substitution or time-out can only be made by giving proper notification to referee.
8. No reaching over or under the net, clapping hands, trying to influence opponents or confuse the officials in any way.
9. No conduct such as swearing, name calling, shouting, taunting, distracting or pointing fingers directly at referees, opponents or spectators. If a player starts to act out as indicated, a warning will be given up to two times. The third time, such player will be ejected from the game.
10. If two or more players of the same team start to act out as in #9 above, it will be considered a team violation. A warning will also be given up to two times. The third time, such team will be forfeiture from the game.
11. If a player or a team (two or more players) physically attacks the referee, opponents or spectators such as strikes, punches, kicks, spits or in any other violent manner, the player or the team will be automatically disqualified from the tournament.
12. The Hmoob Cultural and Community Agency will not responsible for your loss/injury due to personal properties and personal injuries.
